

Moccasin Wallow Road is an east-west connection and evacuation route for the rapidly growing North County area. In addition, Moccasin Wallow Road provides an important economic function and benefit by connecting SeaPort Manatee to the state roadway transportation network. The Moccasin Wallow Road widening project consists of 6.5 miles of roadway between U.S. 41 and U.S. 301. The improvement project will widen the existing 2-lane roadway to 4-lanes, and plans include the addition of bicycle lanes, sidewalks, and a shared-use path. The current project will be designed to expand travel lanes in the future, eventually making Moccasin Wallow Road a 6-lane divided urban roadway.



PROJECT UPDATE

Over the next two weeks, the contractor will continue excavating and installing utilities and drainage structures. Following drainage pipe installation, workers will grade and compact the area in preparation for curb placement. Additionally, crews will continue earthwork for the stormwater retention ponds near the future roundabout on U.S. 301. Work will occur on Moccasin Wallow Road between U.S. 301 and 115th Street East (Segment 1) and Gillette Drive and U.S. 41 (Segment 4). Motorists should expect intermittent lane closures during daytime hours with flagging operations throughout the duration of the project.
