NOTICE OF TRAFFIC SHIFT

As part of the Moccasin Wallow Road Segment 4 Improvements project, traffic on Moccasin Wallow Road will be shifted south to newly constructed roadway from Bud Rhoden Road to Gillette Drive, west of I-75 on Friday, April 26th.

Motorists are urged to exercise caution and observe the new traffic patterns when traveling in this area.

PROJECT INFORMATION

Moccasin Wallow Road is an east-west connection and evacuation route for the rapidly growing North County area. In addition, Moccasin Wallow Road provides an important economic function and benefit by connecting SeaPort Manatee to the state roadway transportation network. The Moccasin Wallow Road widening projects consist of 6.5 miles of roadway between U.S. 41 and U.S. 301. The improvement projects will widen the existing two-lane roadway to four-lanes, and include the addition of bicycle lanes, sidewalks, and a shared-use path. The current projects are designed to expand travel lanes in the future, eventually making Moccasin Wallow Road a sixlane divided urban roadway.
