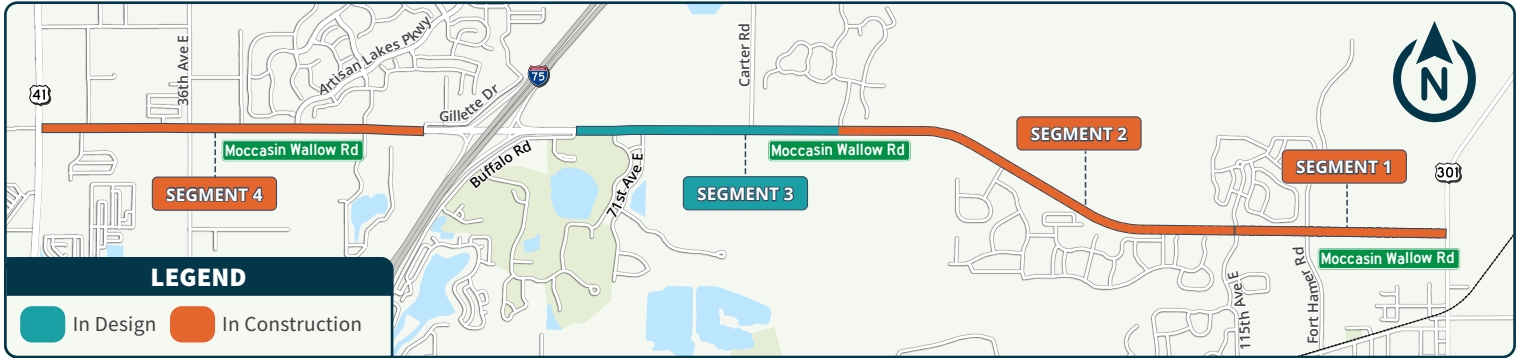




Moccasin Wallow Road Improvements - Segment 2 from 115th Avenue East to Bay Winds Parkway

December 2024



PROJECT INFORMATION

This roadway project will widen approximately 1.6 miles of Moccasin Wallow Road from two lanes to four lanes (two in each direction) between 115th Avenue East and Bay Winds Parkway. This roadway segment will also include a 12-foot-wide multi-use path on the north side of Moccasin Wallow Road, a 6-foot-wide sidewalk on the south side, and 7-foot-wide bicycle lanes in each direction. Median openings will be provided for access to residential communities and the addition of pedestrian-activated crossings, street lighting, and a signalized intersection at Sawgrass Road will improve safety and traffic operations.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- Improves safety for all roadway users along Moccasin Wallow Road by providing additional road capacity, bicycle lanes, sidewalk, and a shared use path
- Provides additional roadway capacity to meet anticipated County growth and higher traffic volumes
- Consistent with the long-range need for higher capacity corridors connecting U.S. 301 to U.S. 41 per Manatee County's adopted Traffic Circulation Plan and as included in the Sarasota-Manatee 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan

COMMUNITY BENEFITS

- Improves vehicular traffic operations and function of the Moccasin Wallow Road corridor
- Will reduce traffic congestion and improve traffic flow throughout the corridor
- New bicycle and pedestrian features will increase safety for non-motorists and provide local connectivity
- Provides access to safe, affordable, accessible, and sustainable mobility for all roadway users

- Construction Cost:** \$35 Million
- Construction Start:** December 2024
- Completion Date:** Mid 2026
