


Moccasin Wallow Road Improvements from U.S. 41 to U.S. 301

Bi-Weekly Update | April 4, 2025



SEGMENT 1 (U.S. Highway 301 to 115th Avenue East):

ANTICIPATED COST AND CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

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Construction Cost: \$28 Million



Construction Start: January 2023



Completion Date: Early 2025

This roadway project widens approximately one mile of Moccasin Wallow Road from two lanes to four lanes (two in each direction) between U.S. 301 and 115th Avenue East. This roadway segment also includes a 12-foot-wide multi-use path on the north side of Moccasin Wallow Road, a 6-foot-wide sidewalk on the south side, and 7-foot-wide bicycle lanes in each direction.

Median openings are provided for access to residential communities and the addition of pedestrianactivated crossings, street lighting, signalized intersections, driveway modifications, and dedicated turn lanes improve safety and traffic operations throughout the roadway corridor.

This segment also includes a roundabout at the U.S. 301 and Moccasin Wallow Road intersection for more efficient traffic flow and improved safety. Roadway drainage has also been improved, with stormwater run off directed to new linear ponds along Moccasin Wallow Road and county right-of-way near the U.S. 301 roundabout.

Current Activities:

The contractor is working to complete pavement markings, the installation of signage, and cleanup/closeout items as work on Segment 1 nears completion.

SEGMENT 2 (115th Avenue East to Bay Winds Parkway):

ANTICIPATED COST AND CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE



Construction Cost: \$35 Million



Construction Start: December 2024



Completion Date: Mid 2026


This roadway project will widen approximately 1.6 miles of Moccasin Wallow Road from two lanes to four lanes (two in each direction) between 115th Avenue East and Bay Winds Parkway. This roadway segment will also include a 12-foot-wide multi-use path on the north side of Moccasin Wallow Road, a 6-foot-wide sidewalk on the south side, and 7-foot-wide bicycle lanes in each direction.

Median openings will be provided for access to residential communities and the addition of pedestrian-activated crossings, street lighting, signalized intersections, driveway modifications, and dedicated turn lanes will improve safety and traffic operations. Roadway drainage will be improved and stormwater run-off will be directed to new linear ponds along Moccasin Wallow Road.



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Current Activities:

Storm drain, waterline, and embankment work are ongoing on Segment 2. The new traffic signal at Sawgrass Road will be activated on April 9. Travelers are advised to use caution driving through the area as traffic becomes accustomed to the new configuration.

SEGMENT 3 (Bayside Community Church to Buffalo Road (east of I-75):

ANTICIPATED COST AND CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

Construction Cost: \$43 Million

Construction Start: Summer 2025

Completion Date: Early 2027

This roadway project will widen approximately 1.8 miles of Moccasin Wallow Road from two lanes to four lanes (two in each direction) between Bayside Community Church and Buffalo Road. This roadway segment will also include a 12-foot-wide multi-use path on the north side of Moccasin Wallow Road, a 6-foot-wide sidewalk on the south side, and 7-foot-wide bicycle lanes in each direction.

Median openings will be provided for access to residential communities and the addition of pedestrian activated crossings, street lighting, signalized intersections, driveway modifications, and dedicated turn lanes will improve safety and traffic operations. Roadway drainage will be improved and stormwater run-off will be directed to new linear ponds along Moccasin Wallow Road.

Current Activities:

This project is completing its land acquisition phase and is being priced by contractors.

SEGMENT 4 (U.S. 41 to Gillette Drive):

ANTICIPATED COST AND CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

Construction Cost: \$49 Million

Construction Start: January 2023

Completion Date: April 2025


This roadway project widens approximately 1.9 miles of Moccasin Wallow Road from two lanes to four lanes (two in each direction) between Gillette Drive (located just west of I-75) and U.S. 41. This roadway segment also includes a 12-foot-wide multi-use path on the north side of Moccasin Wallow Road, a 6-foot-wide sidewalk on the south side, and 7-foot-wide bicycle lanes in each direction.

Median openings are provided for access to residential communities and the addition of pedestrian activated crossings, street lighting, signalized intersections, driveway modifications, and dedicated turn



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lanes improve safety and traffic operations. Roadway drainage is improved with stormwater run-off directed to new linear ponds along Moccasin Wallow Road.

Current Activities:

The contractor is working to complete final activities as construction on Segment 4 nears completion. Beginning in April and continuing through May 2025, a developer will be performing construction activities on Moccasin Wallow Road between Bud Rhoden Road and Artisan Lakes Boulevard to accommodate the new Southpointe community. Travelers are reminded to exercise caution and observe traffic patterns, construction crews, vehicles and equipment when traveling within the project area.
